## Nebraska Synod Theme for February is: Have **THE** Conversation

Conversation is an exchange involving active listening as well as taking turns sharing ideas and stories. It can be easy to fall into monologuing, lecturing, or tuning out especially when we think we know the answers. As a result, we avoid having the difficult conversations. Faith-filled disciples are called to be honest and engage with each other in Christ-like love.

### Questions to Consider:

- What is your prayer when engaging in a hard conversation?
- When was the time you had a hard conversation? What did it feel like? What did you learn from it?
- What is **THE** conversation that you need to **GO** have and with whom?

**Prayer:** Engaging God, who is not afraid of any conversation, give me the words, wisdom, and heart to join in difficult conversations. Amen

### Dear Church Family,

#### *How many times is the phrase, "Do not be afraid," in the Bible? -*

His name is Brad Rodgers. Brad and I attended elementary school, played Little League baseball, and were Cub Scouts in Lyons, NE. Brad's dad was transferred to Kearney, NE, by the NE Dept. of Roads when Brad was a third of the way through seventh grade. End of story, right? Well, no it isn't.

Brad went on to be an MD first in Valentine, NE and from then on in Kearney, NE. When I was called to be the associate pastor at First Lutheran Church in Kearney, NE, our paths crossed again. Brad and his family were members at First Lutheran, not only Brad but his younger sister, Janet, and her family, and Brad's parents, Daryl and Gina Rodgers were members there too!

Brad was also my personal doctor while I was in Kearney with checkups and flu shots. Brad has continued to make these checkups...or better yet, "check-ins" with me yearly with a phone call. The latest was while I was driving to Good Sam in Beatrice to make a few visits. Brad always likes to open with a joke. This is the joke he told me that day, "Why is it wrong to iron a four-leaf clover?" To which I responded, "I don't know Brad, why is it wrong to iron a four-leaf clover?" And here is Brad's punchline, "You should

never press your luck!” And then Brad asked me, “How many times is the phrase, ‘Do not be afraid,’ in the Bible?”

I quickly thought of the angel Gabriel saying this to Zechariah, Mary, and Joseph in the New Testament so I hesitantly said, “Three times.” Brad laughed and said, “No, 365 times!” Then he went on to tell me that through his personal spiritual revival and Bible study, he came across this number of 365 in November of 2023. It was then that he said he is going to apply the phrase “**do not be afraid**” to his daily devotional in 2024 because 2024 is a Leap Year! **Do not be afraid** because God is God and in control so worrying will not make a difference! With ALL that Brad is responsible for he certainly has a strong faith.

**2024 is a Leap Year!** February has 29 days and not 28. I have another friend, Pete Balaban, a pastor in Oklahoma, who in his recent on-air blog (12/27/2023), said that “**do not be afraid**” is equivalent to saying, “**Merry Christmas!**” Pete just had his second knee replacement and was doing his on-air blog from his hospital bed a day after surgery. As of yet, I have never had a knee replacement, but I have a brother who had both his knees done at once, and a sister who had one done and then six weeks later the other. I would guess that both in their recovery said the words, “**Do not be afraid!**” I doubt if either one said, “**Merry Knee Replacement!**”

So, I think I will take up Brad’s challenge and add **do not be afraid** to my daily devotions with Karen. And all the time, in the back of my mind, I will be waiting for Brad’s call!

## **Celebrating God's Work in Progress – Old Business**

- President Alan Folkerts gave an update from Property and Management
  - Stained glass Windows - The work on the windows began January 2, 2024. They are also working on the frames. The window cost has been taken care of through the Endowment Committee.
  - Tuck-point - They should be here in the spring of 2024 to finish.
  - Doors - We will be replacing the doors in the Fellowship Hall. They will use the existing frames. We have a bid of \$10,000.00 for fiberglass doors.

  - **AC Units** - We will be needing new units. 3-4 of the units are not working at all.

  - **Anniversary Committee**- Mert Rademacher presented the update. The theme will be "Reflecting Zion's Past. March 14, 2024 will be the kickoff with Bishop Scott Johnson coming. In July Arden Dorn will be here to assist Pastor and on October 27, 2024 Casey Lieneman will be here. In the old school house will be the Heritage Room. This room will hold items from the past. All of the remodeling done has been by volunteer work.
  - **Park Board** - Paul Jurgens gave an update. The concession stand profit was up by 23.7%. The batting cages, women's restroom were all added and updated. The next project is the retaining wall with the area to the fence to be level so fans can sit and watch the games easily from that area. All of the work has been done by volunteers. Paul gave a thank you to all of those involved.
  - **Cemetery Fence** - Les Lieneman gave an update. They were waiting for approval from the Nebraska state government. This coming year they will proceed. It will be a wrought iron fence to replace the chain link. There will not be any gates.
