Dear Church Family,

Each month I look for an idea, a thought or a scripture to spark my newsletter article. Sometimes it comes easy and sometimes not so easy. This month I looked for a blessing, but not just any run of the mill blessing. I looked for a blessing that was one we don't use on a regular basis and up popped 3rd John 1:2.

In 3rd John 1:2, the apostle John expresses a prayer for Gaius, wishing that he "may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers." This prayer highlights John's deep care for Gaius, that he will thrive in all aspects of life while maintaining a strong faith. Just a reminder that Karen has made for Zion your NEXT PASTOR PRAYER QUILT. The purpose of this quilt, is that every time you either individually or corporately pray for your next pastor, someone will tie knot in the quilt. The more you pray the more knots are tied. So by the time when you call your next pastor, you present this quilt to that pastor. If he or she counts the number of knots tied, they will know how many times you prayed for them to come to Zion and be your shepherd,
