# PREPARATIONS FOR MISSION SUNDAY September 24, 2023

During a preparatory conversation with Simone Weber of **Table Grace Café**, here are the steps that will happen for this event:

1. Depending on the weather forecast, we will need to move park picnic tables to grassy area behind fellowship hall and the area between the fellowship hall and

parsonage. Set out strategic trash receptacles for tableware, cups, etc.

- 2. Rope off area (needed 35 feet) for the **Table Grace** food truck from Elm Road to the concrete space between church and parish hall. The food truck will arrive between 9 to 10 a.m.
- **3.** Set up tables and chairs after Sunday school in parish hall for those who do not wish to sit outside on picnic tables.
- **4.** Set up projector & screen in sanctuary for video during and after worship.
- **5.** Starting with the wisest members, usher out to the food truck in groups of 20 so as not to overload the food truck crew. Asking both high school and junior high youth to help the wisest members navigate both the food truck and seating.
