As we reflect on the past 11+ years with Pastor Jer & Karen, we give thanks for their leadership, love and prayers that sustained us throughout their time at Zion.

Just as Pastor Jer was called to serve at Zion, he & Karen have now accepted the call into retirement. We will miss them dearly and wish them all the best. May God bless them abundantly in their retirement years.

Many of us have built a bond and friendship with Pastor Jer & Karen over the years. As a congregation we can continue our friendship & relationships on a personal level; however, it is not appropriate for us to engage in discussions regarding the church or to seek their advice concerning congregational matters. In addition, we should not reach out to Pastor Jer at emotional & ceremonial times with expectations he will perform any pastoral acts (weddings, funerals, baptisms, home communions, etc.). Such requests can put Pastor Jer & the current minister in awkward positions.

As a congregation, we are moving into a transitional period & will go through a grieving process. Its a time to reflect & pray that God will guide us to find a new Pastor who will meet the needs of Zion. Pastor Jer has asked us to **“Trust the Process”** and the Council is also asking each of you, to **“Trust the Process”**. God will answer our prayers and God will provide.

During the transition and until we find an Interim Pastor, we will call on Pastors listed on the **ELCA Pulpit Supply** to lead our services. We ask for your patience, support, and flexibility during this process along with your prayers to help guide us during this time. We may need to change the Sunday’s we normally celebrate communion, but will try to offer the sacraments twice a month. Communion dates & those leading our service will be listed on the newsletter calendar and in our weekly bulletins.

Lastly, we have formed a committee of individuals who will build our **Ministry Site Profile (MSP)**. This team will share the story of Zion, our mission & who we are. Once complete, the MSP is submitted to the Bishop for approval & ultimately posted on the ELCA website as **Ministry Opportunities** for those seeking a church. The call committee will be formed at a later date. Pastor Greg Berger, Assistant to the Bishop will be at Zion on June 8th to discuss more details.

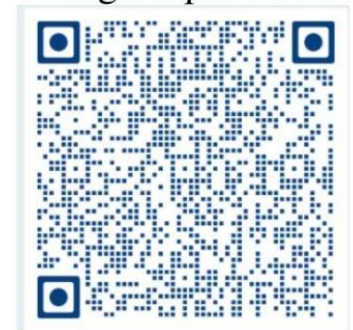


Did you know some of Zion's Choirs made albums? We will feature one song from each of the three albums over the next couple weeks. Alnora Daubendiek has provided some commentary on the albums. We welcome comments or memories.

Young People's Choir

This album was recorded in about 1961, under the direction of John Ehmen. Members of the Young People's Choir were confirmed young people and single young people working in area around Zion, and college students home on weekends. Pastor Arden Dorn does a solo verse; he had started Dana College and was home for the summer. At that time, students got confirmed when they were sophomores in high school. Practice was weekly on Monday evenings, and the choir sang approximately once a month during a service. When the confirmation age changed and school activities involved more time, practice times were difficult. The Young People's Choir was discontinued in the mid 1960's.

There were about 18 members in the choir at this time under the direction of John Ehmen. Practices were weekly on Monday nights, except for the summer. Many of the songs are without accompaniment because until about 1960 there was no piano in church and the organ didn't seem to work well. With the piano added to the church, we could do so many more anthems. The choir always went caroling at

Christmas. It was a busy night starting at 5 pm, with caroling until 8 pm; the night of caroling was finished with eating at Ranch-O at that time.

Junior Choir



The album was made in about 1970, and was recorded in the church. Mary Lou Oltman directed the Junior Choir at that time. Children grades 1-8 sang in the choir and fill the choir loft with about 40 members. They practiced every week for an hour and all the music was memorized.

They sang for church services once a month and sat in the choir loft for the complete service wearing robes. A committee mother assisted on Sunday morning with the robes.
