**March 1, 2026** - A Short Emergency meeting was called to order to review rates of the certificates of deposits that came due for the Seminary CD, the Sinking Fund CD, and the Seminary Savings. A proposal was made and vote taken to take \$10,000 out of the Seminary savings and make it into a CD. We ended up with a 12-month rate of 3.45% APY on the money out of Seminary savings that we made into a CD.

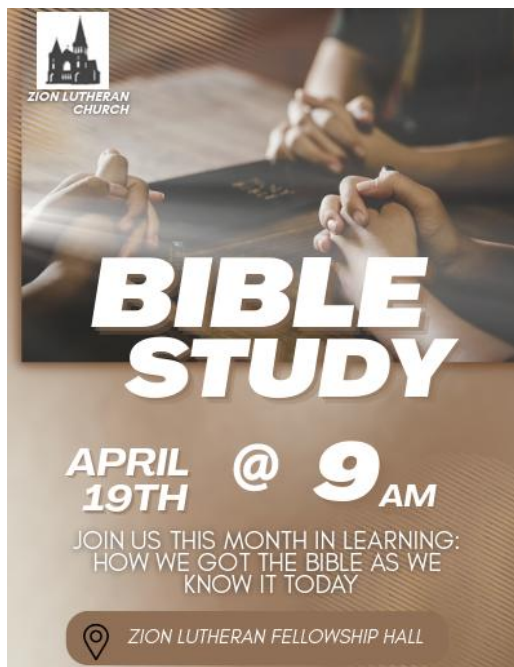

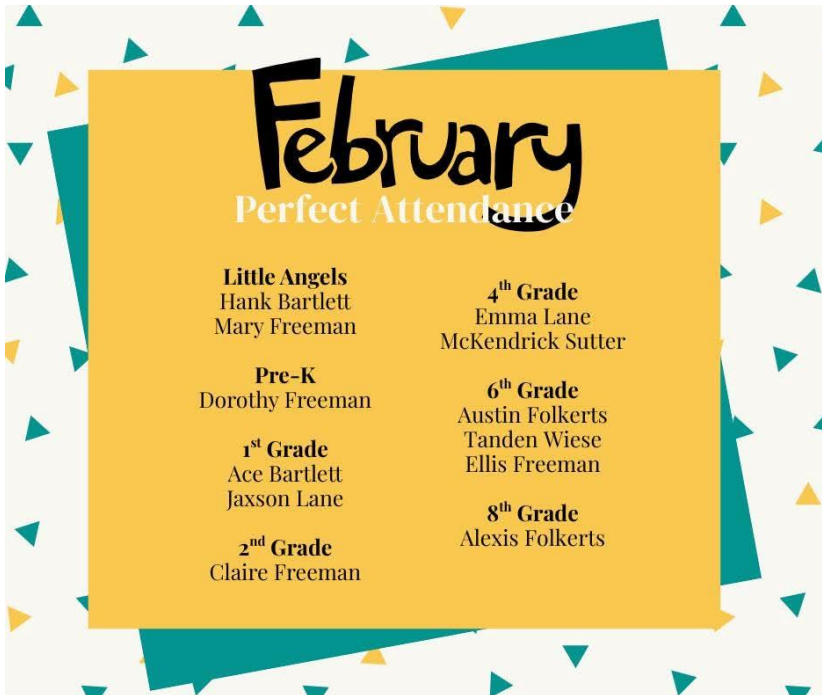
